Christy reported as follows:

The library insurance provider will issue a new check, which covers depreciation for the
work that has already been done to restore the library after the flood. They have
currently committed \$418,000 for the library flood claim. Thus far, Christy has had to

use very little of the \$200,000 authorized by the board in February 2023 to cover unreimbursed expenses.

Strategic Plan Committee -

Christy reported that the strategic planning consultants held focus meetings with seven groups, including teens, seniors, parents of young children, staff, department heads, stakeholders, and board members on July 11-12. The consultants' report of the findings from the community survey and focus groups are expected to be available within two weeks.

Building Committee -

Marge reported that the committee met, reviewed the architect's drawings, and toured the teen and reference areas where the proposed changes will be made. The proposal appears to address existing space concerns that Christy previously identified. The committee authorized Christy to engage the architect to update the drawings and incur the related costs for those drawings.

Arlette noted that the teen area needs to be re-designed to improve the lighting and provide additional space.

The library can apply for a construction aid grant from New York state for this project.

RESOLVED, that on recommendation of the Library Director, the Board of Trustees of the Valley Cottage Library approves the appointment of Sage Weinstock, part-time non-exempt, effective July 7, 2023.
