Annual Appeal/Donations

Donations continue to arrive in response to our letter sent to residents. The appeal will also be published in the Winter Newsletter for the first time this year.

Along with the streamlined annual appeal process, a 'Donate' page was added to our website to gather and promote the various ways to donate to VCL. After fielding questions from people interested in donating, it was clear a single repository resource would be helpful. With help from former staffer, Sean Antonucci on the Eleanor Byrne research, and Ashley Maraffino in developing the webpage, the <u>Donate page</u> is now live offering traditional donations, bookplate donations, and Eleanor Byrne garden donations. On a related note, a 1975 plaque designating the Eleanor Byrne Memorial garden was discovered and is currently at the sign shop getting a garden stake fitted prior to placement on our grounds. This work brings one of Valley Cottage Library's original volunteers, Eleanor Byrne, back to life through research and the eventual reinstallation of the 1975 plaque and reaffirms some of VCLs history.
