3. **Audit Presentation** -

Independent auditors report presented by George Morfogen, stating that as of December 2025 YE financial statement, the firms Independent Auditors Report and Opinion Statement reflect that the Valley Cottage Library's financials are fairly stated. There are some minor language and clarifying adjustments needed in final draft, and the Library will refer to the management letter for suggested adjustments and recommendations.

There was water leaking in Children's Room, same spot as this winters Ice dam. Roofers coming to assess on April 16. Christy will review the warranty on the roof before then. This roof was replaced in 2023.

Arlette Monney states the Valley Cottage Library is still awaiting the balance of the tax revenue (typically arrives in April or May. The Library is operating within the budget and the May outlook is solid.

- HVAC replacement proposal – Children’s Room

- Christy Blanchette reports that a coil in air handler wasn’t working, and the part can’t be replaced since it’s from 2002 and no longer available. Discussion ensued among the Trustees the decision to repair solely the broken section or to take the opportunity to replace the entire HVAC system in the Children’s Room.

Moved by Mary Fiore and seconded by Jemar Ward the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the Valley Cottage Library Board of Trustees approves fully replacing the HVAC system in the Children’s Room.

Motion passes 5-1 with Trustee Roy opposed.
